2011 Volunteer Program Information

The Winnipeg Trap and Skeet Club's Volunteer Program, which enters its third season, continues to be a great success and again members at the 2010 AGM endorsed it. Under the revised program, members are required to either contribute a total of 7.5 points worth of volunteer effort during the year or pay a surcharge of \$75.00 on their membership fee. This program is designed to reduce operating costs as well as to build a strong, vibrant club.

Here's how the program works:

- Along with your membership application, a post-dated cheque for \$75.00 must be provided and will be cashed if your volunteer commitment is not completed in full by August 30th
- Upon completion of your volunteer time, your un-cashed cheque will be returned to you marked VOID
- There are many opportunities throughout the year for members to assist in the operation of the club
- Look for the volunteer opportunity sign-up sheets in the clubhouse commencing April 2011. Hours will be recorded daily by the manager, so please don't forget to report them. (Must be reported on the same day). It is best to check in with the manager prior to starting your volunteer task.
- The volunteer program cut-off for the 2011 shooting year is Sept 30th 2011. Points earned after this date will be applied to the 2012 program. For 2011, the BoD has open up the opportunity for both pro-rating your efforts as well as sharing of hours between members.
- First year and Life members are exempt from this program but are welcome to help out.
- Junior members again are exempt, but will be asked to contribute to the club in a way that will be organized by the Junior Program Coordinators.

Grass cutting (must be trained)	8 pts/cut
Flower planting/care season	3 pts
Tree care season	3 pts
Weed whacking (entire grounds)	4 pts/day
Load trap houses (filling machines)	.5 pts/house
Clean trap houses	1 pt
Load skeet houses (filling machines)	.5 pts/house
Clean skeet houses	1 pt
Moving targets from boxcar to houses	2 pts/truck load
Club opening	2 pts
Club closing	2 pts
Unloading target shipments	6 pts per load
Infrastructure care :trap/sheet houses benches, stands, racks	2 pts/hour
Canteen: week nights	1 pt/hr
Canteen: weekends/holidays	1 pt/hr
Clean clubhouse (vacuum, wash floors, washrooms, etc).	1 pt/hr
Facility general clean-up (hulls, boxes, garbage)	1 pt/hr
